Cell Phones and Social Media



On September 1, 2024, Alberta Education implemented new standards restricting the use of personal mobile devices in schools and access to social media on school networks.

At St. Alphonsus we ask all students to keep their cell phones in their locker or locked behind their teacher's desk during the day.

JH Locks & Lockers

This year all junior high students will be provided a school owned lock for their locker. The replacement fee will be \$9.50.

e4c School Nutrition Program

This year e4c will be providing elementary students a morning meal. The e4c school nutrition program is designed to address food insecurity in a child's life by providing essential nutritional support while they are at school. By offering a morning meal, we aim to ensure that all students start their day with the nutrition they need to succeed academically and behaviourally. This program will begin on Tuesday, August 12, 2024.

What does this mean for families?

The morning meal will be served to *elementary* students from 8:15 AM to 8:40 AM. This program is universally accessible to all elementary students, who are encouraged to participate whenever they feel hungry or need additional nutritional support. Permission for students who accessed the program last year will automatically roll over. New students will be provided a permission form to ensure we are meeting all dietary needs.

Elementary students will be able to come in the front doors at 8:15 AM. They will collect their morning meal in the front lobby and take it to eat in their classroom. Students will still have a designated lunchtime to enjoy lunch and snacks brought from home. Please ensure your child brings a healthy lunch to school every day.

Junior High Students

We will continue to open our front doors for junior high students who want to access our JH Breakfast Program at the concession at 8:00 AM.
