### **VACATIONS**

These in-person interactions are key to deeper and more effective learning.

Our school calendar includes scheduled vacation breaks, and we encourage families to plan trips during those times. Teachers are not required to provide assignments for vacations, but some work may be completed and submitted online. If submitted on time, teachers can provide feedback.

Please remember that classroom learning is carefully planned to meet government guidelines, which emphasize in-person instruction. To ensure your child gets the most from their education, we ask that you plan vacations around the school calendar.
