Free City of Edmonton Passes - Interested?

Families considered to be low income are eligible to receive free leisure passes. What does this include?

These passes include memberships for the entire family to City of Edmonton sites (recreation centres, the Edmonton Zoo, Fort Edmonton Park, outdoor pools, and more). Access to recreation centres include a variety of activities such as swimming, workout facilities, childminding services, indoor playgrounds and more.

But did you know?

Pass holders ALSO get public transit passes for a reduced cost and also get access to 75% off registered programs for kids AND adults in the family. Registered programs include activities such as swimming lessons, music lessons, art classes, summer camps etc.

We will be hosting a group application session April 10th!

April 10th between 2 pm and 6 pm You are free to drop in and get support with an application into the program. This date has been picked because it will allow families to register in April and receive their passes in June; just in time for summer break! During this event, we will be available to support you in applying for this pass and exploring registered program options.
